

Jesus Makes All Things New...Even You!

Rev. 21:5 *And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new.*

2 Cor. 5:17 *Therefore if anyone be in Christ, they are a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.* (Colossians 3 is a complete description of us becoming new)

Key Scriptures and Points

Rev. 1:17-18

17 *Fear not; I (Jesus) am the first and the last: (At the end of all things who is left standing, Satan or Jesus? There are only two sides. Whose side are you on?)*

18 *I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.*

(Before Jesus died on the cross, Satan used the keys of Hell and death to imprison people behind bars of fear. Who has the keys now? Jesus does not imprison us...He sets us free from Hell and death!)

Isa. 14:12-15 *(Who is left standing at the end, Satan or Jesus?)*

12 *How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!*

13 *For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north:*

14 *I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.*

15 *Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.*

Rev. 20:10

And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

Rev. 1:19 *(Let's look at some of the amazing things that shall be hereafter!)*

19 *Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter;*

Isaiah 11:6-9 *(No more viciousness from animals)*

6 *The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid; and the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; and a little child shall lead them.*

7 *And the cow and the bear shall feed; their young ones shall lie down together: and the lion shall eat straw like the ox.*

8 *And the sucking child shall play on the hole of the poisonous snake, and the weaned child shall put his hand on the serpent's den.*

9 *They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.*

Rev. 21:1-5 *(New Heaven, New Earth, New You!)*

1 *And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.*

2 *And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.*

3 *And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.*

4 *And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.*

5 *And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful.*

Rev. 21:22-27 *(No Temples, No Hindrances for anyone wanting to see and talk with God)*

22 *And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.*

23 *And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.*

24 *And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it.*

25 *And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there.*

26 *And they shall bring the glory and honour of the nations into it.*

27 *And there shall in no wise enter into it anything that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.*

Conclusions

Jesus and Father God have seen the end of the world's sin-damage. Heaven was defiled by Satan's rebellion; Earth was defiled by Adam's, Eve's, Cain's, and the whole world's rebellion.
