Main Scriptures & Points

Php. 1

1. vv. 9-11, Wary of complacency and status quo.
2. vv. 12-14, Wary of shrinking back when threatened for the Gospel's sake.
3. vv. 15-17, Wary of so-called Christians, who are egotistical and looking to seize control.
4. v. 20, Wary of bringing shame and reproach on the ministry and validity of Christianity.
5. v. 20b-30, Wary that your devotion to Christ might seem superficial to others.

6. vv. 1-16, Wary of individualism, strife, vainglory, murmurings, and disputings.
7. vv. 19-30, Wary of self-centered, self-elevating, leaders.

Php 3

8. vv. 2-3, Wary of vicious, religious, plotting leaders that protect their view like guard dogs.
9. vv. 3-11, Wary of trusting our own fleshly frame of mind for pleasing God.
10. vv. 12-19, Wary of weariness in the pursuit of God's high calling.

Php 4

11. v. 1, Wary of letting our hold on Christ slip.
12. v. 2, Wary to settle disputes between Christians.
13. v. 3, Wary to lift up and help those who are laboring for Christ.
14. v. 4, Wary of anything diminishing your joy in Christ.
15. v. 5, Wary of an appetite of excess that seems inordinate for Christians.
16. vv. 6-7, Wary of worry that causes one to forget to pray.
17. v. 8, Wary of negative influences that can make one appear un-Christlike.
18. v. 9, Wary of failing to find and follow those worthy of being mentors and models to us.
19. vv. 10-12, 14-19, Wary of becoming a stingy Christian or church.
20. v. 13, Wary of trusting in our own strength and not Christ's.
